As always, as your local Vicar, this magazine comes with many blessings and prayers for you all.



Welcome to Ritah Namakula, our new curate



Revd Ritah Namakula, on her first Sunday as St John's new curate, flanked by her son Kisakye and daughter Kirabo.

My name is Ritah. I am the new curate at St John's in Southdown. I was ordained on 1st July 2023. I have two children, my son Kisakye (Grace of God) and my daughter Kirabo (Gift of God). I was born in Uganda, East Africa. I went to faith schools there and it was while I was in secondary school that I gave my life to Christ. I have lived in the UK for more than thirty years.

We have been in Southdown for a month now and everyone has been very kind and welcoming to all of us. I have struggled to learn everyone's name, but in time I will. I am looking forward to getting to know everyone.

We worshipped at Christ Church and St John's Church, Radlett, for more than 16 years. It was while at Christ Church that I started my journey of discernment. Unlike most people I did not have the road to Damascus moment. It was my vicar at Christ Church, ten years ago, who approached me and talked to me about considering serving God in ordained ministry. I had never considered this and at the time I felt that I was serving God where I was and helping when help was needed. My vicar encouraged me to pray about this and to go on the St Albans Diocese 'Seeking the Way' course to find out if this was what God was asking me to do. I did and here I am now serving God.

Flower Guild

An oasis of flowers?

In 1954 Oasis was invented which revolutionised the art of flower arranging. Before that chicken wire was used which gave limited scope for accuracy of design. Now we realise that Oasis, because of its plastic composition, is harmful to the environment so we are trying various ways to do without it. To this end St John's Flower Guild invited Julie Amor of the Abbey Flower Guild to show us how they do things. This she did - using chicken wire - so we have come full circle!



Now Harvest is upon us when most of the 23 St John's Flower Guild members will roll up their sleeves to fill the church with colour incorporating food bank items into their designs. If you love and appreciate the beauty of flowers, why not come and join us. Members take turns on a rota and work together, sharing our enjoyment of flowers in the peace and tranquillity of the church.

This year's Harvest Appeal supports Mission Direct's work in Kumi, Uganda, by providing materially poor families with chickens. These give them a sustainable and low-cost food source, and provide an income stream because they can sell some of their eggs and new chicks that hatch. Their first hatchlings are returned to the project so that another family can benefit.



Mission Direct is a small Hertfordshire-based Christian charity that takes volunteers overseas to work short term in partnership with local communities, building hope and bringing change through practical and sustainable development.

Many thanks to all church members who delivered envelopes and to everyone who donated so generously to this year's Christian Aid (CA) Appeal.

Harpenden raised the grand total of £6,666 including Gift Aid and many more will have given directly online.

Our efforts have never been more vital, as poor farmers in **Malawi** struggle to cope with inflation and the climate crisis, for which they are not at all responsible. CA are helping them survive and prosper, by switching to drought-resistant pigeon peas, which can feed their families and create sustainable incomes.

Otherwise, CA is actively involved in **Ukraine**. The catastrophic dam disaster on 6th June 2023 has flooded at least 37 towns and villages with thousands forced to leave their homes. CA's local partner immediately responded with emergency supplies of food, water and shelter and will continue to support longer term.

September — Desi Page from Friends of Tose tells us about the work at Tose Respite Care Centre in Zimbabwe where they provide life-saving care and a loving home for children and young people with severe mental and physical disabilities.

October — Linda Randall talks about Talking Books. This RNIB Service is absolutely free and books are also offered in Braille. The service began in 1935 when books were provided to war blinded soldiers. Talking Books are also offered by digital download and up to six books at a time may be borrowed. What a brilliant resource this is!


