



DID YOU KNOW? Holy Family?

Have you ever pondered at how the first Christmas is portrayed as 'perfect'? For a start Mary had a pregnancy of exactly nine months, and we don't hear any mention of crying baby Jesus or anything else about having a new baby. Mary and Joseph must have had just as much of a challenge as any new parents, with sleepless nights and nappies and a steep learning curve. If you are thinking you might not quite 'fit in' with what St John's does at Christmas, think again. 'Perfect' or imperfect, your presence matters and you are most welcome.

Thoughts on a Green Christmas

Our society places a high value on 'owning' and 'being up to date'. We can feel pressure to buy 'stuff' we don't really need. Almost everything we buy depletes the world's resources, and over-consumption is the biggest driver of climate change. If you'd like to learn more about our finite resources and the

It's great to give presents. But is it possible to do this in a greener way, with less of an impact on the world's resources? To reduce waste, we need to tackle both ends of the cycle; buying less and recycling more. Here are a few ideas:

- Make your own. Home-made cakes, biscuits, preserves, cards...
- Go for a plastic-free Christmas. Avoid plastics in presents, wrapping paper, cards, crackers, etc. Plastics are made of oil, and hard to recycle.
- Buy presents made from recycled materials.
- Buy second-hand or recycle/upcycle yourself. Books, toys, games...
- Give cinema or concert tickets, memberships or subscriptions...
- Donate to charity instead of giving presents. Many charities supply gift cards and there is a huge range of projects to support.

Scam season! 🔨











The Christmas holidays are a great time of year. Many of us buy gifts online, some pack up and visit family or travel for skiing. It may surprise you that cyber criminals enjoy this season too - if you are getting deliveries, expecting the winter fuel allowance or booking a holiday be on the look-out for targeted scams.

Strong indicators that you are dealing with a cyber-criminal include:

- Suspicious communications such as an unexpected cancellation, a refund or a fine.
- Fake offers or discounts that sound too good to be true.
- Requests for credit card details over text, WhatsApp, email or other social media platforms.
- Unexpected phone calls.

If you are concerned about a suspicious message:

- do not use any of the contact details in the message itself.
- do not click any of the links.
- do not scan any QR codes (they are the same as links!).
- do not open attachments.

If you are using a mobile phone to read emails, stop, and go view the message on an iPad, tablet, Mac or PC – the screen is bigger, so it's easier to spot the misspellings, logos or vagueness that indicate a scam. If you still have doubts contact the company or holiday booking agent directly through their customer service team. Do not use the email you received to find contact details!

If you have received a scam email forward it to report@phishing.gov.uk or forward scam texts to 7726. There have been over 40 million scams reported since the launch of this scheme back in 2020 so you're in good company.

If you realise you've been scammed:

- Stop all communications with the scammer, do not appeal to their good side they simply want your money and don't care how it affects you.
- Contact your bank using the contact details on your bank card or dial 1-5-9 and ask to be put through to your bank.
- Finally report it to Action Fraud via their web site www.actionfraud.police.uk who have lots of further advice for you.

It started as a trip to Peru to see his sister-in-law and grew into an exciting new link across the Anglican Communion – all because Revd Tim went to church on a Sunday. Visiting Lima's Anglican Cathedral in 2024 Tim struck up a friendship with the Dean. Impressed by their ministry to some of Peru's poorest people, St John's fundraised for their mission as part of our Christmas Appeal in 2024, raising £2,200. In 2025 Revd Tim went to see how the money was being used, and took the opportunity to know more of the Anglican Church in Peru.






Toddler Service

Local Treasures: The Conroy Family

'Max is the brains of the business,' the Conroy family laugh fondly as they pet their brindle dachshund. The business is Party Box and its heart is the family who have been a presence in Southdown since the 1970s. Their shop location, on Piggotshill Lane, has over the years been a hairdresser, a toy shop, and finally a party supplies shop. But it was only when the Covid pandemic threatened to shut down Party Box that the Conroys took over running the operation themselves. 'I didn't even know how to blow up helium balloons!' says Alessandra. 'There was local demand,' explains Lawson, 'and we wanted to keep it going. There's community involvement, it's a service.'

Life is full for Alessandra, When not helping people at the counter, she does the Grove School run for the youngest of their three children, walks Max and manages all the busyness of family life - 'I hope people are forgiving if now and then they find the 'Shop Closed' sign in the door.'

Besides cards and decorations for birthdays from age 1 to 100, Party Box covers engagements, weddings, anniversaries and births as well as occasions like Christmas and Valentines Day. Among special items are pinatas, personalised balloons, recyclable latex balloons, even Christmas cards you can plant, plus sparklers for New Years Eve. An extra bonus leading up to Christmas - now and then Santa visits in person!
