# Churchwardens' report CHURCH LIFE – Big and small

t is only one year since Tim, our vicar, began at St John's but it has passed like a whirlwind which shook us up with so many new initiatives and events that kept the church wardens, and many others, quite well occupied.

Our patron saint, John the Baptist, had his life and significance to Christianity recognised by the church in general on 24th June. So, on the nearest Sunday, the 26<sup>th</sup>, we held our celebration of our patron. After a lovely service a social occasion was highlighted by an exhibition of the history of St John's Church in Harpenden going back to the 19th century. This linked to 2022 and Project Phoenix - the campaign to raise funds to replace the existing elderly hall with a new community facility. The day included coffee and cake, then a barbecue with drinks, followed by some exquisite puddings, fruit salad, and more cakes. Everyone sat in the vicarage garden in the sun (thanks to God and the weatherman) to eat, drink, chat and listen to live music. Children enjoyed fun activities, and a rounders match on the common 'rounded up' the day.

Although we write here of one special event and give thanks to the legions of generous people who volunteered their help, every single day someone is actively supporting the church and the community, mostly unseen and unsung. The results of some of their efforts can be seen by walking around the outside of the building, or entering into its cool, quiet space. In the fast pace of life, the hurly burly of organising, doing, reviewing, improving and planning, just to sit quietly for five minutes in the church, or outside on the bench in the sun, can be most restorative and helps us to remember God is present in small unnoticed things too.

Autumn in the church is a bit like a school term, with special traditional services such as Harvest, Remembrance, Advent, Christmas, alongside the wider gamut of daily and weekly events and even non-events. Certainly, Harvest will be possibly more significant this year, owing to factors already affecting the supply and cost of food, and our thanks for it will be all the more heartfelt. After the relaxation of the summer, a new start in the autumn brings a renewed focus on what is most important to us, both the big and the small.

## St John's new Parish Centre back on track

The project to build a new Parish Centre at St John's to serve the people of Southdown and the wider Harpenden community has re-launched.

The current hall is over 50 years old and although currently in use, an enhanced Parish Centre will serve not just St John's, but also provide a muchneeded community space.

The re-launch event on 26<sup>th</sup> June was opened by the youngest and oldest persons present in a celebration of the history of St John's.

The Story of St John's -- now available on stjohnsharpenden.org.uk/exhibition -- follows the origins of the church from its beginning in 1865, the burning down of the old St John's in 1905, the construction of the current church in 1907-8 and various additions over time. The new Parish Centre is about enriching the current generation, as well as leaving a legacy for the next.



Local Councillor Brian Ellis said, "A new Parish Centre will enable St John's to expand its good work in the community and will be a valuable asset for people of all faiths and of none. I wish the fundraising every success."

# **Repair Fair** Saturday 15 October St Albans 2.00 – 5.00 pm



Don't chuck it, repair it! St Albans District Fixers are coming to St John's Parish Hall to help repair household fabrics and electrical items you might otherwise throw away.

This is part of a wider initiative to reduce waste, save people money and in the longer term prevent our planet from being destroyed by over exploitation of our shared resources.

The St Albans District Fixers are part of Sustainable St Albans. They hold Repair Fairs around the district inspired by The Restart Project. Fixing rather than buying replacements has already saved thousands of tons from going to landfill or incineration helping in a not insignificant way to reduce our CO2 emissions.

So on Saturday 15th October bring along your faulty electrical items and worn, torn fabrics. The team of skilled amateur fixers will do their best to put them right or offer advice. You may even learn to repair things yourself!

The fixers run a booking system for the event and you can book a time for your repair on the fixers page of the Sustainable St Albans website or via the fixers Facebook page. Bookings will open on the 15th September. There are always a few open slots but booking assures the team can help you.

# Mothers' Union news



I have never grown runner beans before. Having downsized from a large garden to a courtyard filled with pots I smiled when my daughter presented me with a small pot containing two tiny shoots. Before long I had two trips to the garden centre to buy longer canes as these intrepid plants clung, twisted and climbed!

When I sat in the sunshine enjoying a coffee they delighted me! Clinging through the strongest wind, they twisted on up during the heaviest downpour and eventually they provided me with a dish of delicious beans to eat with some butter and a sprinkling of pepper.

The last two and a half years have been difficult for us all and we needed to hang on and remain positive. Did we manage to grow spiritually and reach for the light? Did we work towards something which enriched our lives and benefited others? Did we help others to smile because of actions we took?

Mothers' Union does all that. We are a Christian Organisation of over 4 million members in 84 countries. Members demonstrate their Christian faith by working at grass roots level to transform communities. The 28 members of St John's Branch work with the Diocese to offer support to women in local refuges. A few further examples:

- Helping families under stress through Away from it All holidays
- Sending Christmas cards to those in prison
- Supporting local hospitals with baby items, wash bags and activity packs
- Raising funds for the MU Jubilee Summer of Hope Appeal

As we struggle with rising prices, the continued threat of Covid, the warnings of climate change and threatened industrial action it is easy to become disheartened. Mothers' Union members put their trust in God and "continue climbing up towards the light."

# St John's Eco Church ECO & CHURCH



### Coming soon

- As part of our commitment to cutting wastage of precious resources, we are holding a **Repair Fair** on Saturday October 15<sup>th</sup>. Run by St Albans District Fixers, a group of experienced volunteers will repair items people bring in, for free. (For details see page 11.)
- St John's is hoping to become **carbon neutral** by 2030. In preparation for this, we are carrying out an audit of all the energy that we use in the day-to-day life of the church. This includes heating and lighting, but also travel, food and drink, rubbish disposal, and all consumables, like paper, cleaning products, etc. We have just completed a "travel to church" survey for the whole congregation. This is the first step towards reducing our greenhouse gas emissions.

### Recent news

- We regularly hold a **Traidcraft** stall, selling Fairtrade goods (tea, coffee, chocolate, cards, etc) at St John's. Fairtrade means worker's rights, safer working conditions and fair prices for the farmers and growers, and high quality, ethically produced goods for shoppers.
- Many of us took part in **The Big Plastic Count** in May, counting the pieces of single-use plastic we used in a week. I try hard to restrict single-use plastic, yet I still used over 70 items in one week. This information was collected nationally, as a step towards understanding and stopping the plastic crisis. See <u>https://thebigplasticcount.com/</u> for more details. We will be doing this again next year, if you want to join us.

# CHRISTIAN AID WEEK 2022 christian

Zimbabwe rarely hits the headlines, though there was a recent report that inflation had reached 191%!! (Now



that really is a "cost of living crisis"!) Fortunately, Christian Aid Week this year, 15th to 21st May, focussed on Zimbabwe and the desperate plight of women farmers trying to feed their families during a prolonged drought. For the first time in a generation, global poverty is rising. Coronavirus, conflict and the climate crisis are pushing more of our global neighbours into a struggle for survival. As the climate crisis rages on, vulnerable communities in Zimbabwe face the threat of more intense droughts, floods and storms.

But there is hope. With the support of Christian Aid, farmers can learn how to grow drought-resistant crops and turn their barren land into a garden of plenty.

So, many thanks to all church members who delivered envelopes and to everyone who donated so generously to this year's Christian Aid Appeal. Harpenden raised the grand total of £5,911 in cash including Gift Aid and many more will have given directly online. St John's own website raised another £362.50.

Otherwise, Christian's Aid's Ukraine Appeal (which includes about £21m from the national DEC Appeal) is supporting five key partner organisations in Ukraine, Hungary and Romania, providing food, emergency aid and shelter, as well as supplying trauma first aid emergency kits and medical supplies to the Ukrainian Ministry of Health.

Looking ahead, there will be a Harvest Horn of Africa appeal to help the millions of people facing drought and starvation, exacerbated by dwindling wheat supplies, as Russia prevents Ukraine from exporting its crops.
