

Junior Choir Grows

St John's newly formed Junior Choir has gone from strength to strength since its formation at the end of 2024. The choir rehearses for 30 minutes, twice a month on Sundays immediately after the morning Eucharist, and joins the Church Choir on the first Sunday of each month and other special occasions, including weddings, and the Service of Lessons and Carols at Christmas. Members are aged from 7 to 12; they receive free musical training, as well as pocket money for their commitment!



Rewrite Their Future: improve access to education

This year's Bishop's Harvest partners with Mission Direct whose work in Uganda and Zambia focusses on building schools in some of the world's most under-resourced communities. After one year, their schools will serve over 2,945 children. At a time when 250 million children globally are not in school, this is one small but vital way we can help change that reality.



DID YOU KNOW?

The St Albans Mayoralty was established over four centuries ago. This year when Councillor Teresa Heritage, one of the elected District Councillors for Harpenden South Ward, was elected St Albans and District Mayor she selected St John's Revd Tim Vickers as her curate. Resplendent in her formal Chain of Office, red gown and tricorn hat, the Mayor now has a purely civic role. Her duties include supporting and raising funds for specific charities. Teresa has chosen Community First Responders and Pancreatic Cancer UK. Come time for religious aspects like the annual Mayor's Civic service at St Albans Cathedral and the Beating of the Bounds ceremony, Revd Tim undertakes the religious roles for the mayor.

Stamps, blister packs and more

Local recycle update

- St John's continues to recycle used postage stamps, candles and greetings cards (not Christmas cards). There are collection boxes in the porch.
- Boots in Harpenden are now accepting empty pill blister packs. This is linked to their recycling app, so that you can get Advantage points. The app also accepts some hard to recycle branded beauty products.
- The Green House in St Albans (46 London Road, AL1 1NG) also take empty blister packs, printer ink cartridges and dental care items. The Green House is a community eco-hub for St Albans, Harpenden and surrounding villages, and well worth investigating: https://thegreenhousestalbans.org/

Please note that any unwanted pills should be taken to your chemist for disposal, and not put in the recycling bins.

Fairtrade Fortnight September 22nd – October 5th

St John's is a Fairtrade Church, using Fairtrade tea, coffee and sugar, and encouraging people to buy Fairtrade in their weekly shop.

Fairtrade is about better prices, decent working conditions, local sustainability, and fair terms of trade for farmers and workers around the world. By requiring companies to pay sustainable prices (never lower than the market price), Fairtrade addresses the injustices of conventional trade, which traditionally discriminates against the producers from low-income countries. On food stuffs and craft goods, the Fairtrade symbol means the product meets international Fairtrade standards. See https://www.fairtrade.org.uk/



She trained to be a florist at Oaklands College in St Albans later in life when her three daughters were at school. Stephanie worked in a few florists before opening her first shop in Station Road in 2004, and then moved to Leyton Green in 2012.

An independent shop, not part of a national chain, Stephanie finds its success still overwhelming after almost 21 years. Stephanie credits this to her wonderful customers, her amazing staff and especially Elaine, her most loyal and talented florist.

Called 'Stephanie Randall, The Flower Studio' her shop's style is a nudge to the Dickensian period (think sparkling chandeliers, hustle and bustle, and lots of bows).
