Even though we all know it was best for our own safety, it was still hard for many – especially those who live on their own or were relying on the generosity of others. I found myself unable to see my brother who had recently arrived from Peru.

So, for many reasons, this year Christmas will feel like the first 'proper' Christmas in 2 years, and I hope that you not only have plans, but also that you are going to take extra pleasure in the joy of seeing family and friends at Christmas.

When plans for Christmas were changed last year, many said that Christmas was cancelled. Of course, in one sense that was true – our cultural celebration of Christmas was put on hold for a year. 

# Churchwardens' Report

s we write this, we are enjoying the late golden sun and the intense colours of autumn; the cold, clear, night skies reveal bright stars and planets, before the grey, bleak, darkness of the winter closes in. Yet, there is still reason to be cheerful as the season also has its own warmth and light, albeit in a different form.

Autumn began with the installation of our new vicar, Tim, which was a most joyful occasion and a new beginning for St. John's. Tim has planned an expansion of the provision and variety of services which have been curtailed by the vacancy and the coronavirus situation.

Young people have returned to schools, colleges, and universities, to take up and continue, their covid-interrupted studies. Prayers were held for their endeavours, the effectiveness of their essential equipment, the commitment of their teachers, and their academic success, but most of all for their supportive friendships and the hope of new beginnings at these important stages of life.

The significance of traditional Harvest was evident in the displays in the church during two special services: one for all ages, and our first choral evensong for nearly two years. However, it was acknowledged that Harvest, giving and sharing, also applied in many other aspects of our lives.

Our church is open every day, except Friday, for private prayer and for morning and evening prayer. We are blessed to have a talented team of florists who embellish it through their beautiful displays. We also thank the dedicated cleaners who care for our sacred space. Furnishings that were banished for coronavirus reasons, such as the kneelers, both useful, colourful, and full of symbolism, have been cleaned and put back in place. Overall, the church looks less austere and more welcoming.

Our church will continue at present with the online Sunday morning service on YouTube at 9.30 am to offer opportunities for those who cannot come to the building or feel nervous about it. Enormous thanks to everyone who facilitate our services both in obvious ways, and in less apparent, yet essential ways, such as operating the sound system and the live recording.

November is the time for remembrance: at the very beginning of the month are All Saints and All Souls Days when our prayers for those who have died are particularly focused upon individuals and all those who have passed on. Following on from this, comes the annual appreciation of all those who have died in conflicts in the service of our country, and whose tremendous efforts and sacrifices have enabled us to live in peace. The pandemic has meant that bereavement, loss, and remembrance of the dead are even more poignant, and has encouraged a deeper reflection upon life too.

We are looking forward to Christmas, the celebration of Jesus's birth. The senior members of our congregation may remember Christmases past when conflict and austerity impacted upon that season. However

# A surprise from Strathdon

hen I was a little boy, growing up in Redbourn, I had a Granny who lived in a small hamlet in Aberdeenshire near the Cairngorm mountains. There was just one shop near by, the general store in a village 4 miles down the road and that was the only shop she ever went to. On my birthday I looked forward to the parcel with her writing on it as I knew it would contain an interesting, unique present that no one at my school would already have – and that made it very special.



It strikes me that the current ability to shop via the internet or drive to a big shopping centre provides a great deal of choice but the intimacy of a relationship with your local shopkeeper, the community and local economy is lost - as well of course as the damage done to our environment. Clothing or other gifts made in far-off countries and transported by container ships which consume tons of low-grade bunker fuel



by the hour and affects the health of those living in coastal regions around the world, adding to greenhouse gas emissions and therefore increase global warming.

An 18-month study undertaken by six PhD students in Environmental Science at Radboud University in the Netherlands reported in July 2020 that one of the main issues with online shopping is people only buy a few items per purchase. When they shop in a store, they combine their choices into a single bulk purchase. Frequent online purchases produce more packaging waste, and online items tend to come from different distribution centres adding to the number of road journeys made. Both factors result in higher greenhouse gas emissions per item; ordering from online-only retailers produces the most emissions. This is as a result of failed deliveries, high rates of returns on items bought online, and longer distances from warehouses to individual homes. And with the advent of free two-day or even one-day shipping,

We are very lucky with our shops here in Southdown and Harpenden generally. We also have access to the farmers' market, craft fairs and the art fair. Shopping here is about interacting with real people, providing them with a living and gaining an enjoyable experience as well as the goods we purchase. Walking to your local shops helps to reduce your carbon footprint as emissions from cars account for 15% of the

UK's overall carbon emissions.

So, in the run up to this Christmas, please try to shop locally where you can, with the knowledge that you are supporting the community as well as reducing your impact on the environment.

## Advent Book Club: Comfortable Words

This Advent, we're encouraging you to hear the comfortable (and hopeful) words of scripture and join us in reading a series of reflections on lockdown by the Bishop of Oxford, Rt Revd Steven Croft.


Through nine reflections, Steven Croft examines what these 'comfortable words' have to say to us. Each reflection begins from a passage of scripture taken from Isaiah 40—55: the song of an unnamed prophet who sings at the end of the exile to call God's people home.

The prophet sings of love and forgiveness, of new hope and strength in God, to rekindle courage in the hearts of God's people. The prophet sings of a new kind of leadership, based on humility and gentleness. The prophet sings to tell us not to be afraid even in the face of death. These are comfortable words the whole world needs to hear afresh in this season.

Do pick up a copy of the book, read it and join us to discuss the themes and questions raised by the book for those exploring faith today.


