As Director of Music at St John's for nearly eighteen months, it is greatly rewarding to see the choir grow in confidence and expand its repertoire. The introduction of our junior choir is a truly exciting development. With ten talented young singers already involved, this group brings great enthusiasm and makes a welcome contribution to the overall choral sound.

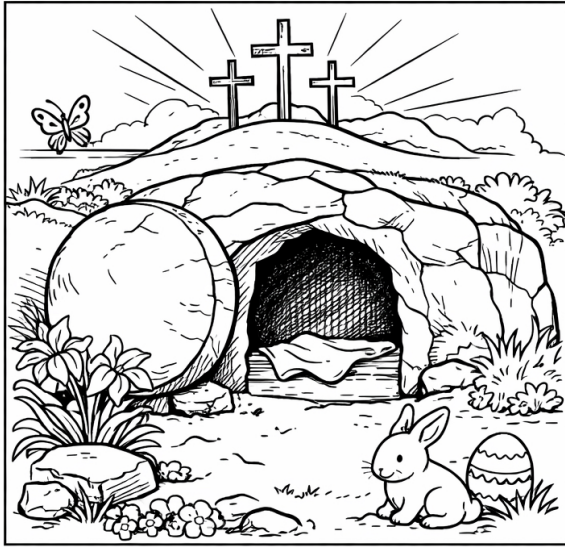

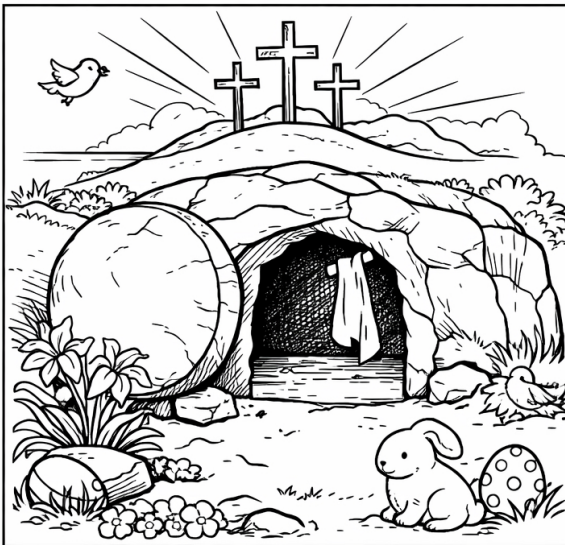

## A next step in faith

### Confirmation at St John's



St John's is to host the deanery confirmation service on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June at 7.30pm. Bishop Rob Wickham will conduct the service for candidates from all the parishes in our area. If you are looking to explore the next step in your faith, then it would be great to do so at St John's. We are starting preparation sessions from March for adults and children Year 7 and up aimed at helping you explore what it means to be a Christian and be a follower of Jesus. ## Swift nest boxes

Soaring, screaming swifts are one of the evocative sights and sounds of summer, here to breed for a few months before returning to Africa. Every April I look out for them, hoping they will return, as sadly their numbers have plummeted by 65% in just 25 years. You can still see swifts in Harpenden, especially around Milton Road/Topstreet Way, but they are in serious trouble.

Swifts are in decline because they have fewer places to breed and less food. They nest under the eaves of buildings or in crevices in walls. This is bad news when building refurbishments mean these nooks and crannies are lost. Swifts eat as many as 100,000 flying insects a day. It's a huge energy requirement, and with insects declining at a faster rate than ever before, many swifts just can't find enough food to sustain themselves.

However, there is hope. In Herts dedicated local groups are taking action to protect and support swifts. These groups run surveys to find breeding sites, work to prevent nesting holes from being blocked, install nest boxes, and raise awareness.

At St John's we are installing two swift nest boxes on the north side of the church, with help from the Northeast Herts Swift Group. The money for the boxes has been donated in memory of Liz Neville, who was a great supporter of Eco church, and very keen to help swifts. Several members of the congregation are also getting swift nest boxes installed.

## Need a prayer?

St John's is open for private prayer every day 10.00am - 5.00pm. If you would like someone to pray for you, please do get in touch with the Vicar or with our St Luke's Cell Prayer Group (01582 765576).

St Luke's group prays individually and meets monthly to pray together for anyone in the parish who asks for themselves or for others. The Cell has been continuously a part of St John's since the 1960s. At the group's monthly short service we share any updates on those for whom we pray, and add others, including those mentioned by the Ministry Team. Sometimes a prayer written many years ago can give us the words we need just now:

*Jesus, when all is darkness and we feel our weakness and helplessness, give us the sense of Your presence, Your love and Your strength. 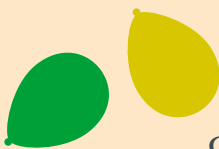

# What does a vicar do?

## It's not just Sundays...



**Prayer and lead worship:** This might sound obvious, but the church doesn't only meet to worship and pray on Sundays. St John's holds a service of Morning Prayer every weekday morning at 9.30am, a midweek Eucharist on Wednesdays at 10.30am, a Toddler service on Thursday at 10.15am, and a monthly Healing Prayer service (the St Luke's prayer cell - see p21). It's a great privilege to pray for the world, community, church, the sick and the dead, so when we say we will pray for you we really do mean it.

**Entertainer:** Whilst I don't get booked to entertain at parties, sometimes my job as a vicar requires an aspect of showmanship – whether it is leading 'Beer and Carols' or getting a point across at a school assembly. The truth is that this is not my natural personality type so I've had to learn how to nurture this aspect of myself in my nearly 10 years in ministry. You'll have to be the judge of how well I manage.

**Swimming:** Now I don't get paid to swim, nor is it part of my job description, but whilst I can be called on at any hour to visit the sick or dying, I can also fit in during my days (when I'm organised) things that matter to me for my health and well-being. Swimming is where I go to process and think things through – it's where a lot of my good sermon ideas come from. So if you see me at the pool you'll know why. Where do you go to help yourself process and reflect?
